Building Blocks for Environmental Governance and Rule of Law




UNEP Governing Council Decision 27/9 recognizes a number of "mutually supporting governance features", including

- coordination of roles. . .
- environmental auditing, and
- criminal, civil and administrative enforcement
- with timely, impartial and independent dispute resolution
